
THE GOSPEL WHAT MUST BE Proclaimed, Understood, Believed? The Key Passage 1 Corinthians 15



The Resurrection of Christ

Peter to Cornelius. Acts 10:39-41 (ESV)



Inasmuch as many have undertaken to compile a narrative of the things that have been accomplished among us, 2 just as those who from the beginning were eyewitnesses and ministers of the word have delivered them to us, 3 it seemed good to me also, having followed all things closely for some time past, to write an orderly account for you, most excellent Theophilus, 4 that you may have certainty concerning the things you have been taught.

1 John 4:14 (ESV) — 14 And we have seen and testify that the Father has sent his Son to be the Savior of the world.




